Pursuant to Section 54954 of the Government Code the Puente Hills Habitat Preservation Authority (Authority), a Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Authority will be held at the call of the Chairperson of the Authority at the above time and place for the purpose of:

2. Report by Citizens Technical Advisory Committee.
3. Consent Calendar:

  - b. Receive and file the Authority’s Portfolio Earnings Reports and Custom Position by Instrument Type for May 2020 and June 2020 prepared by the County of Los Angeles Treasurer and Tax Collector.

4. Verbal update and discussion about response to trail, trailhead and parking lot openings and closures in response to the pandemic.
5. Discussion and possible action approving comment letter in response to the Draft Environmental Impact Statement regarding Regulations Governing the Take of Migratory Birds.
6. Discussion and possible action regarding draft Authority Correspondence Policy.
7. Discussion and possible action regarding the feasibility of pursuing a financing mechanism for the Authority such as a benefit assessment district or community facility district.
8. Discussion and possible action updating the Authority Restoration Guidelines.
