## NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS Fuel Modification in the Whittier/Hacienda Heights Puente Hills Preserve- MECHANICAL

The Puente Hills Habitat Preservation Authority (Habitat Authority), a local public entity of the State of California, requests proposals from contractors that demonstrate (a) professional qualifications for satisfactory performance of task(s); (b) a fair and reasonable price; and (c) evidence that the person performing services possesses the expertise and experience. The work is for fuel modification (weed abatement) services for properties in Whittier/Hacienda Heights.

The following provisions apply to this project:

All work shall be compatible with the requirements set by the Los Angeles County Fire Department; when in conflict ask for clarification by Habitat Authority representative. The successful contractor will sign a Contract Agreement with the Habitat Authority prior to starting work. See specifications on website for details. Work shall be done when conditions don't render it a fire hazard and are mutually agreed upon with the Habitat Authority.

Clearance to be consistent with the Los Angeles County Fire Department requirements as determined by Habitat Authority at their sole discretion. The work includes clearing at least once a year, plus any necessary follow-up clearings. Clearing must be completed by mid May, weather permitting, unless otherwise instructed by the Executive Director or her designee. The contract will be valid for one year, renewable up to five consecutive years total. Please indicate annual market cost increases. This is a prevailing wage project, and no bond is required.
