Recommendation:

That the Board approve the attached comment letter.

Background:

The proposed East San Gabriel Valley Area Plan (Area Plan) is an extension of the Los Angeles County General Plan focused on the unique characteristics and needs of the East San Gabriel Valley Planning Area. The Area Plan would update and consolidate two existing community plans (Rowland Heights and Hacienda Heights), as well as change zoning and land use designations to bring them into conformance with the General Plan. On August 9th the Regional Planning Commission conducted a public hearing to consider the Final Environmental Impact Report for the Area Plan. The Authority submitted a letter prior to this meeting, specifically in support of the proposed land use designation change on the Aera property, which is directly adjacent to the Harbor Boulevard wildlife underpass at the eastern end of the Preserve. The proposed land use designation, Rural Lands 40, would constrain residential development to 1 unit per 40 acres. This property is in private ownership with high potential for residential buildout in the future and is considered the "Missing Middle" of the Puente-Chino Hills Wildlife Corridor to which the Authority's Puente Hills Preserve is biologically connected and dependent.

At its public hearing, the Regional Planning Commission recommended that the County Board of Supervisors adopt the Area Plan. The Board of Supervisor's public hearing is anticipated to be held in January 2024. Please see the Authority's attached draft comment letter addressed to the Board of Supervisors (Exhibit A).

The Puente Hills Habitat Preservation Authority (Habitat Authority) appreciates the opportunity to comment on the East San Gabriel Valley Area Plan (Area Plan) and supports it.

The Habitat Authority is a public joint powers authority established pursuant to California Government Code Section 6500 *et seq.* with a Board of Directors consisting of the City of Whittier, County of Los Angeles, Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County, and the community of Hacienda Heights. According to its mission, the Habitat Authority is dedicated to the acquisition, restoration, and management of open space in the Puente Hills for preservation of the land in perpetuity, with the primary purpose to protect the biological diversity. Additionally, the agency endeavors to provide opportunities for outdoor education and lowimpact recreation.

In the Puente Hills, the Habitat Authority manages the open space in its ownership as well as the open space of Board Member agencies, totaling over 3,880 acres, within the Cities of Whittier, La Habra Heights and the County unincorporated area known as Hacienda Heights. These lands are collectively referred to as the Puente Hills Preserve (Preserve) and are situated along, and within, the southern boundary of the Area Plan.

The Area Plan includes a portion of the Puente-Chino Hills Wildlife Corridor, a span of open space linking the Puente Hills and Chino Hills to the Santa Ana Mountains. Significant public investment has been made to assemble and protect the wildlife corridor over the past several decades, however, the large contiguous portion that comprises the middle span of the wildlife corridor remains unprotected, and this land is absolutely crucial for ensuring the long-term sustainability of the corridor and the ecosystems therein. **Given the significance of this area for wildlife movement, we applaud the proposed change of these parcel's Land Use** Page 2 ESGVAP Habitat Authority

Designation from Transitional Open Space to the lowest housing density designation, Rural Lands 40 and urge the Board of Supervisors to approve the document.

Background:

In March 2023, the Board approved a contract in the amount of \$102,231.42 with TeamCivX for specialized public outreach, communication and educational consulting services. This includes the services of designing and mailing informational materials. This proposed amendment would fund this service. The new contract amount would be in the amount of \$148,196.42.

An informational jumbo postcard, sized at 8.5" x 13", in the amount of \$45,965 is proposed for mailing to 95,444 households within the communities of Whittier, Roland Heights, La Habra Heights and Hacienda Heights. The purpose of the mailer is to provide information to local households about the public services provided by this agency. As was discovered through informational gathering efforts of consultant FM3 last spring, the community is largely unaware of who the agency is and what it does.

Attached is the contract amendment for consideration.

Fiscal Impact:

The funding for this would be from the agency Access Fees funds from Powder Canyon.

A. PHHPA and Contractor entered into the Agreement on December 1, 2022. Consultant agreed to provide professional services for specialized public outreach, educational services, and strategy consulting services related to a possible Community Financing District as a financing mechanism, for a Term ending November 2024, and total compensation in the amount of 102,231.42.

B. PHHPA now wishes to fund the services of designing and mailing informational materials in the amount of \$45,965. The new contract amount would be \$148,196.42.

AGREEMENT

1. PHHPA and Consultant agree to the following amendments (added text in *bold italics*, deleted text in strikethrough):

Section 1.01(d) is amended to read:

<u>Public Information and Stakeholder Outreach</u>. CONSULTANT shall perform any of the following services as needed to raise awareness of PHHPA, its funding needs and the Revenue Measure proposal, each of the services to be subject to PHHPA's approval:

1) Develop communication plan for PHHPA based on needs;

2) Develop informational fact sheets to be distributed at community functions;

3) Provide content related to the Revenue Measure to be added to PHHPA's website, included in email updates and added to newsletters;

4) Prepare PowerPoint presentations for community meetings;

5) Write, design, and produce mailings to educate, inform and engage voters, *including 8.5 x 13 postcard mailer in January 2024 or February 2024 to the surrounding community of approximately 95,000 households*;

6) Develop strategies and plans to inform and engage key internal stakeholder groups;7) Develop strategies and plans to inform and engage influential external groups including elected leaders, business leaders, city leaders, ethnic community leaders, faith community leaders, taxpayer groups, labor organizations, and others

Section 3.01 of the Agreement is amended to read:

The total payment for all services on a Time and Materials basis based on the rates as provided in Exhibit A and shall not exceed \$102,231.42 (one hundred two thousand, two hundred thrity one Dollars and 42 cents)\$148,196.42 (one hundred forty eight thousand one hundred ninety six dollars and forty two cents), payable on receipt of invoices on no less than a monthly basis. Additional change orders for costs above the stated contract price need to be pre-approved by PHHPA in writing prior to work being conducted. Invoices shall include a summary of work completed, and shall be payable on a monthly basis. The Base Consulting Fee of \$7,200 per month as stated in Exhibit A shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis for the initial and/or final month of service if less than a full calendar month before and after contract pauses or when the contract ends. Background:

In April 2019, the Board approved a five-year contract in the amount of \$287,284.64, with NorthStar for annual fuel modification hand clearing work on Whittier and Hacienda Heights Authority-managed properties.

The current contract with NorthStar expires April 2024. The current workload of staff presents a challenge for effectively issuing a request for proposals to continue these services. An extension of the existing contract for an additional year would bring this contract in alignment with the timing of the current fuel modification contract for Authority properties in La Habra Heights with contractor California Arborist, which expires March 2025. Requests for proposals for these two contracts have been issued concurrently in the past.

This proposed amendment with contractor NorthStar would augment the contract an additional year at the current annual cost of 63,793.91, and extend the term from 4/1/24 to 3/31/25, bringing it into alignment with another Authority fuel modification contract.

Attached is the contract amendment for consideration.

Fiscal Impact:

None. The funding for this contract is from the agency CalFire grant agreement (#5GG20144).

Section 3 of the Agreement is amended to read:

Compensation: HABITAT AUTHORITY shall pay the amount of \$53,017 (fifty-three thousand seventeen dollars) as specified by CONTRACTOR in Contractor's Proposal, and incorporated herein as Exhibit C as full compensation to CONTRACTOR for furnishing all materials and for doing all the WORK contemplated and embraced in this Contract, also for all loss or damage arising out of the nature of the WORK aforesaid, from the actions of the elements, from any unforeseen difficulties or obstructions which may arise or be encountered in the prosecution of the WORK until its acceptance by HABITAT AUTHORITY, and for all risks of every description connected with the WORK, also for all expenses incurred by or in consequence of the suspension or discontinuance of the WORK, for all well and faithfully completing the WORK, and the whole thereof, in the manner and according to the Contract Documents. The Contract may be extended annually up to four additional terms, totaling five consecutive years at the sole option of the HABITAT AUTHORITY by providing notice in writing to CONTRACTOR. Compensation for possible additional years are presented in proposal (Exhibit C) are as follows: Year 2-Contractor's \$54.607.51. Year 3- \$56,245.74, Year 4-\$59,620.48, and Year 5- \$63,793.91; and Year 6 - \$63,794.

(Should there be a conflict of the TERM in the Bidding documents, the CONTRACT shall be the binding terms.)
